# Information About FYNIRS

Living outside of residence can be very challenging. For instance, you might find yourself between classes with nothing to do and not enough time to go home. In addition, you may find it difficult to make friends that can relate or help with your living experience: i.e. paying rent, transportation, becoming familiar with your neighbourhood, etc.

FYNIRS, or First Years Not in Residence Students, is a student-run organization at Queen's University that is dedicated to welcoming incoming first year students who do not live in residence. We attempt to ensure that these students, regardless of what faculty they may be in, are able to access the same resources as students who live in residence. We do this in three main ways:

*ORIENTATION:* We are proud to offer, once again, our annual orientation, which will be taking place on September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010. This orientation effectively replaces residence orientation, ensuring that participants are aware of key services at Queen's and in Kingston. At the same time one is learning about his/her new environment, he or she will have the opportunity to socialize with other peers and participate in a variety of fun activities, including a boat cruise on the final night. It is a mainstay of this orientation that friendships are formed which will last beyond one's attendance at Queen's. If interested, please see the registration form on the next page.

*YEAR-ROUND EVENTS:* All is not over after orientation. We ensure that FYNIRS has an event at least once a month and everyone is welcome to participate as well as propose ideas for future events. Past events have included board game/video game tournaments, holiday banquets, and haunted tours of Fort Henry and the City of Kingston.

*LOUNGE:* While you may not have easy access to residence lounges, ours will always be open and supervised by senior FYNIRS during the school day – it is a convenient spot for storage, shopping downtown, catching up with friends, studying, and playing games or watching television. We can guarantee that time between classes won't be a bore!
